JOINT AGENCY AND PUBLIC MEETING
ROCKY MOUNTAIN PUMPED STORAGE HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT
FERC NO. 2725**

Oglethorpe Power Corporation (An Electric Membership Corporation) (OPC), on behalf of itself and co-licensees Georgia Power Company, Rocky Mountain Leasing Corporation, and U.S. Bank National Association, will host a Joint Agency and Public Meeting on March 16, 2022, to discuss the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) relicensing of the Rocky Mountain Pumped Storage Hydroelectric Project (Project) (FERC No. 2725). The Project is an existing hydroelectric facility located in Floyd County, GA on Heath Creek approximately 10 miles northwest of Rome, GA. The Project has an installed capacity of 904 megawatts and includes a 221-acre upper reservoir, a 600-acre lower reservoir, a powerhouse, and two auxiliary pools totaling 600 acres. The purpose of the meeting is to: 1) provide an overview of the Project, including a virtual site visit; 2) review information about the Project; and 3) discuss and answer questions about the data and studies to be developed by OPC as part of the consultation process.

The meeting will be held twice on March 16, 2022: first from 2:00 to 4:00 PM and again from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. The meeting will be held virtually through the online platform Webex. A virtual tour of Project facilities will be presented at each meeting.
